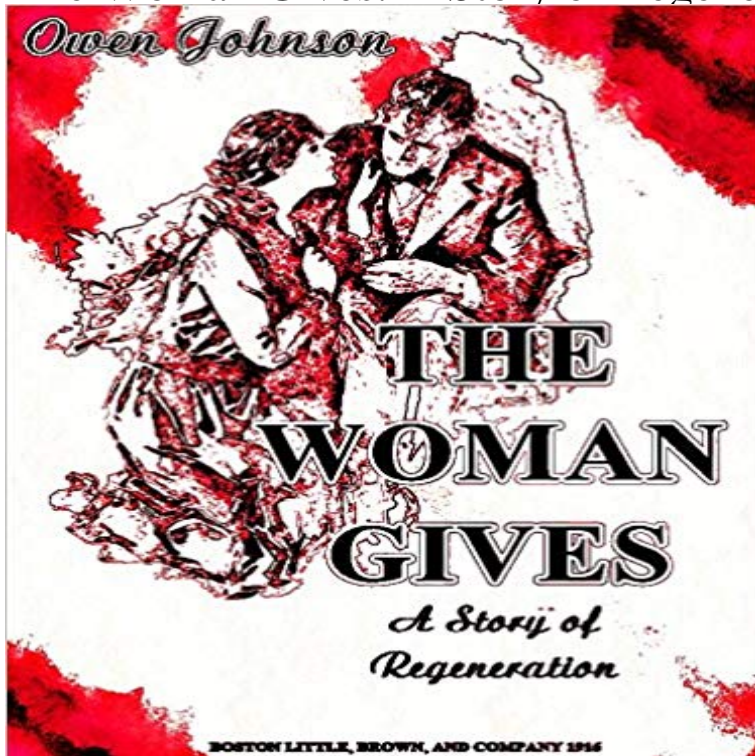


The Woman Gives: A Story of Regeneration
