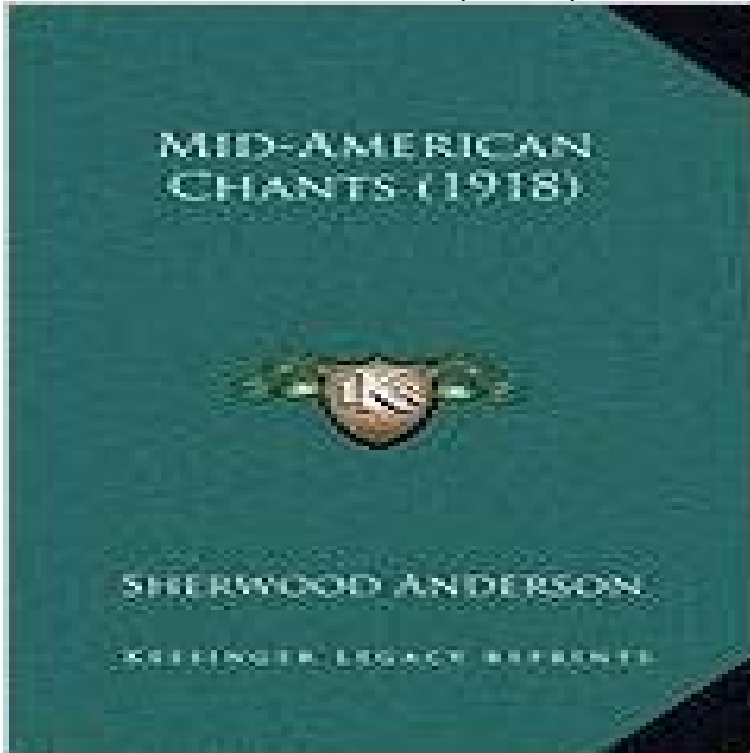


Mid-American Chants (1918)
