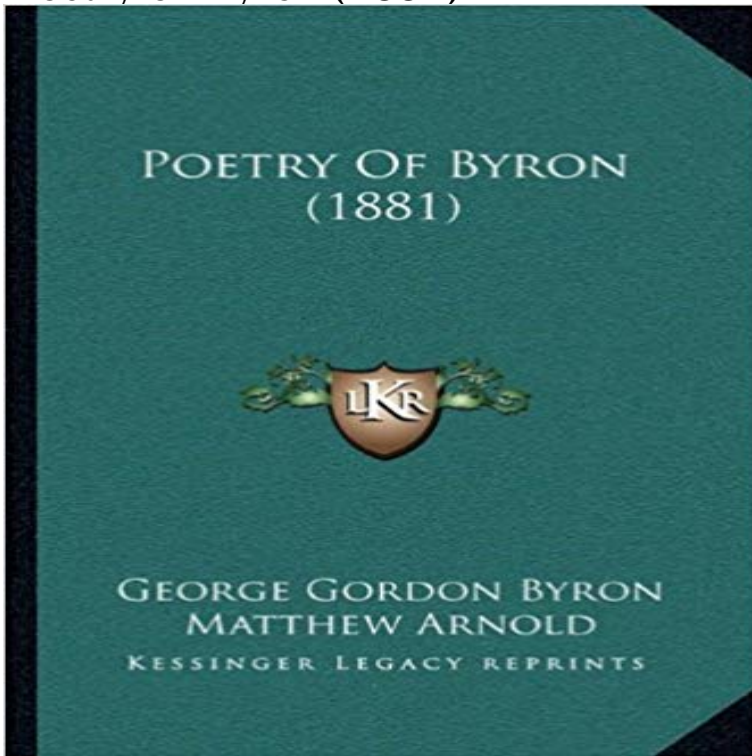


## Poetry of Byron (1881)
